Requirements

The 2011 Classic Challenge is designed to be a very straightforward event to enjoy. Two people must be in the car at all times. All you need is the following:

- > A current drivers licence
- > AASA Club or equivalent competition licence (which we can issue: AASA license - no test involved - \$50 for 1-year)
- > A good quality helmet for each person

The car needs:

- > To be in sound and roadworthy condition (cars will be inspected at the Friday evening Scrutineering)
- > A checked & date-tagged 2kg fire extinguisher (or 2 x 1kg units, one of which must be accessible in the cockpit)
- > An approved first aid kit

Note: There is no requirement for items such as extra bonnet catches, roll-cages, oil catch tanks, race suits, etc.
